NATIONAL CAMPAIGN KICKOFF HONORS VETERANS

AMERICAN INDIAN AND ALASKA NATIVE VETERANS MONUMENT

Riverside – On November 10, 2014 California committee members of AIAN Veterans Monument will meet at a proposed monument site on the grounds of Riverside National Cemetery to announce a nationwide awareness campaign to recognize the contributions of Native American Indian and Alaska Native Veterans. American Indians have the highest record of military service per capita of any ethnic group.

Brigadier General Stan Brown, USAF (Ret.), and Baxter Miller, Chairman of the Board of RNC Memorials & Monuments, will be available to discuss this legacy and monument on *Monday, November 10, 2014, at 10:00 A.M.* at Riverside National Cemetery, 22495 Van Buren Blvd., Riverside, CA 92518. *Flag pavilion plaza overlooking the lake and proposed memorial site.

The American Indian Veterans Memorial will be the first national memorial to specifically honor the unprecedented service of American Indian and Alaska Native Veterans at any of our nation's cemeteries. Riverside National Cemetery is home to several existing national memorials including the Medal of Honor Memorial, the Veterans Memorial, and the POW/MIA Memorial.
