AMERICAN INDIAN AND ALASKA NATIVE VETERANS MONUMENT CAMPAIGN

Riverside – On November 10, 2014 a historic campaign to recognize the contributions of Native American Indian and Alaska Native Veterans gets underway. Individuals and organizations will be able to sponsor Native American and Alaska Native Veterans through a nationwide internet campaign. The purpose of the monument is to honor the legacy of AIAN Veterans who have served in the U. S. military. Organizers are seeking 111,000 sponsorships which represents the number of AIAN Veterans who have demonstrated courage and dedication in defending their country since World War One.
